


The botanical genius of these peoples is not limited to medicine but includes extraordinary agricultural knowledge as well.

Pre-Columbian farmers, without benefit of the wheel or draft animal, discovered and domesticated more than half of the modern world's seven major food crops (corn, potatoes, sweet potatoes and cassava, tomatoes, peanuts, chile peppers, chocolate, vanilla, pineapples, papayas, passion fruits and avocados).

Agri-culture, must be thought of as "the culture which is forged on the land".

In the slums (les favelas, los barrios) where epidemics like: malaria, yellow fever, and Chagas desease, which were thought to have disappeared, unfortunately still have a strong prevalence.



All species fight to survive.

Bacteria fight antibiotics through resistance.


Every 20 minutes they replicate and a new generation through spontaneous mutation is born.

Every year one and a half million people die from bacteria (superbugs) which was once treatable.

In 2050 We will be 10 billion.


But with low-dose antibiotics, farm animals grow faster... and it does not matter if their droppings contaminate land and water, magnifying their resistance.

In a few years we will find ourselves in a condition similar to the pre-antibiotic era.

We need to find solutions and cures and we must go down uncertain paths, but this time armed with knowledge, acquired skills, by identifying the needs and asking the right questions.


Keeping in mind that there is so much we still don't know.
